



## **2009-2010 Financial Aid Application process**

### **Summer 2009 – Spring 2010**

**Recommended completion date is April 30.** Files are awarded in date order of completion, as funds are available, about 12 weeks after all steps below are completed.

- 1) PIN and **2009-2010** FAFSA application:

- 2) Data Sheet: available in office and on web

- 3) Other required documents, if needed and requested by mail from the Financial Aid office
- 4) (**optional**) Student Loan promissory note, entrance counseling, and Direct Loan Request form (form and information on web, [www.shoreline.edu/financialaid](http://www.shoreline.edu/financialaid), Forms )
- 5) Transfer Degree—if in a transfer program, then submit to Admissions the request form and transcripts from other colleges attended within the past 10 years (*credit evaluation request form available in office or on web*)
- 6) Admissions application at: [www.shoreline.edu](http://www.shoreline.edu), choose “Apply Now”
